Harrisburg Update

21-22 Session Begins

- **History made in the House and Senate**
- **Republicans continue to control House and Senate, with a larger majority in the House**
- **\$915 Million COVID Relief Bill signed into law, focusing on restaurants, hospitality, education and homeowner support**

Governor Wolf's Proposed FY 21-22 Budget

- **\$37.8 Billion or a \$3.8 Billion increase**
- **PIT increase from 3.07% to 4.46%, raises \$2.964 Billion**
- **Waiting to see what will be in the new Federal COVID Relief Bill**



KEY Legislative Issues for PAELA in 2020

- Digital Assets- after three Session this Bill signed into law
- Remote Notary, both temporary and permanent
- Governor Veto's COVID Liability Changes
